Nikkiso selected as supplier for Safran Cabin's Trash Compactors, and signs Supply Agreement

Nikkiso Co., Ltd. (hereafter "Nikkiso") is pleased to announce the successful start of delivering trash compactor component parts to Safran Cabin, one of the world's leading manufacturers of aircraft interiors. Safran Cabin and Nikkiso have signed a long-term supply agreement to commence the new business. Nikkiso has been expanding its business with aircraft configuration parts such as cascades and winglets. As a next step, this new business with Safran Cabin, involving the addition of aircraft interior components, signifies the expansion of Nikkiso's capability and product variation.

The newly started production of trash compactor components include aluminum parts used in the "Trash Compactor" located in galleys (kitchen facilities on an aircraft). During the development phase in preparation for production, Nikkiso successfully met the flame-retardant specifications, which are difficult and unique requirements necessary for aircraft interior parts. Additionally, through its past experiences with aircraft and satellite parts, Nikkiso has strengthened its knowledge and capability in handling metal bonding techniques and honeycomb core materials (beehive-shaped reinforcing parts). As a result of this history, Nikkiso has contributed to providing weight reduction and strength to the trash compactor components.

The trash compactor products are manufactured at Nikkiso Vietnam, Inc. (Hung Yen Province, a suburb of Hanoi, Vietnam; hereafter "NVI"), a wholly owned subsidiary of Nikkiso. NVI began manufacturing aircraft parts in 2011 and has developed advanced manufacturing technologies for products utilizing not only CFRP (carbon fiber reinforced plastic) but also metals, honeycomb cores, and other multi-materials. In 2018, NVI started operations at its second plant, which currently produces a wide variety of aircraft parts, mainly wing components.

With the recent recovery in demand for aircraft as a tailwind, Nikkiso will continue to expand its product variation and strengthen its supply capabilities by leveraging its accumulated technologies and production capacity at NVI.

About Nikkiso

Since its establishment in 1953, Nikkiso has contributed to solving social issues by anticipating the changing times with world-first and Japan-first technologies and products. In the industrial business, Nikkiso has created new markets by developing products in the energy field, hemodialysis-related products in the medical business, and CFRP (carbon fiber reinforced plastic) aerostructures in the aerospace business.
