YWBCH 2026 will bring together leading researchers, clinicians, healthcare professionals, and stakeholders from around the world to share the latest advances in breast cancer and health issues affecting young women. The conference aims to foster multidisciplinary and international collaboration while promoting the integration of scientific innovation and compassionate care.

Abstract submissions are invited across a wide range of oncology-related fields, including basic and translational research, clinical studies, epidemiology, survivorship, and healthcare policy. Submissions may include original research, ongoing studies, case reports, reviews, and preliminary findings.
