Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for entry into the online DP pilot, students must meet the following criteria:

Language:	Academic English ability (high school level)
Residence:	Must reside in Japan or in a timezone within 3 hours of Japan Standard Time for the duration of studies.
Academic:	Must have successfully completed the Middle Years Programme (MYP) or an equivalent high school preparatory curriculum.
