# Disaster Preparedness Day for foreign residents

Hosted by: Aoba-Japan International School (in cooperation with Nerima ward)

Aoba-Japan International School (Location: Nerima ward, Tokyo "A-JIS") will hold a disaster preparedness day in cooperation with Nerima Ward, the Tokyo Metropolitan Police Detachment (Hikarigaoka Detachment), the Tokyo Metropolitan Fire Department (Hikarigaoka Detachment), and the Hikarigaoka Residential Association. The event is for foreigners residing in Nerima Ward to help them prepare for disasters. It will be held at the Hikarigaoka Campus of A-JIS on Saturday, February 1st, 2014.

As the number of foreign residents is increasing in Japan due to globalization, these residents have been increasingly concerned about the availability of information regarding what should be done in a real disaster situation. A-JIS, a designated evacuation center, has also heard these concerns.

As a result, A-JIS, in cooperation with the local municipality and emergency services, is hosting a Disaster Preparedness Day for foreigners residing in the Nerima Ward. It has been four years since such an event has been held in the Nerima Ward, and it is the first time for A-JIS to host one.

The event will be conducted in Japanese and translated into English, Korean, and Chinese. Information will be provided on issues such as when to evacuate to designated stations, how to use these stations, what items are necessary during a disaster situation, and whether information can be obtained in languages other than Japanese. The event will include disaster recovery dog teams, an earthquake simulator, and a number of specific kinds of disaster information stations. There will also be an opportunity to sample food that is typically used in during disaster relief. The hope is that that this disaster preparedness event will help in creating a community where non-Japanese speaking families can live with a peace of mind.

Disaster Preparedness Day at A-JIS is a family event that is intended to be both informative and interesting for residents of all ages. Join us for what should be a great day of learning for everyone.


