# Aoba-Japan International School to hold "CHOOSE JAPAN EDUCATION FAIR 2014" (2014.2.7)

~A venue where high school students in Japan can interact with

Universities providing international education~

Aoba-Japan International School ("A-JIS")(Location: Nerima-ku, Tokyo), will hold an event "CHOOSE JAPAN EDUCATION FAIR 2014" on February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at the A-JIS campus in Nerima-ku, Tokyo. This event aims to provide a venue for high school students residing in Japan an opportunity to interact with and obtain information on Japanese universities that provide international education with English as its language of instruction.

A-JIS is operated by Aoba International Educational Systems ("Aoba") (Head Office: Tokyo, Nerima-ku), which became a subsidiary of Business Breakthrough Inc.("BBT") (Location: Tokyo, Chiyoda-ku, President: Kenichi Ohmae) in October 2013.

Reflecting the various discussions on the globalization of education, an increasing number of schools, especially universities, are actively starting to provide education with an international focus. Information on these universities however, have not been effectively conveyed to students attending international schools in Japan, as these universities have not (traditionally) taken into full consideration those students who already have a background of international education at the high school level.

In fact, for such students receiving education in international schools (or other schools outside the Japanese system) there has been very little comprehensive information on actual options to attend Japanese universities. Consequently, many students have chosen to go to colleges and universities outside Japan.

Against this backdrop, A-JIS, a school operated by BBT's subsidiary has decided to hold an event-"CHOOSE JAPAN EDUCATION FAIR 2014"-, which will bring together such high school students residing in Japan and those universities providing global education in English.

This event aims to allow those high school students to know more about Japanese universities that provide international education. We will invite universities that offer international programs, including those that are part of the "Global 30<sup>1</sup>"- a project aiming to foster globally minded persons by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology ("MEXT") - who will make presentations to the high school students. Also, there will be an opportunity for university staff and students to interact face-to-face, and students will be able to gather information on issues of their interest. We have also asked for sponsorships from foreign companies that have offices in Japan, so that those companies could also use this venue to project their messages to high school students and universities.

A-JIS, since its foundation in 1976 at Aobadai, Meguro-ku, has provided an education impartial to all educational systems and religions around the world. The curriculum is operated so that one can

acquire both the positive aspects of Japan as well as an understanding for diversity and English language skills that will be necessary to thrive in the global society. In 2013, the school has applied for the International Baccalaureate for elementary school (PYP-Primary Years Programme), and is now a candidate school.
