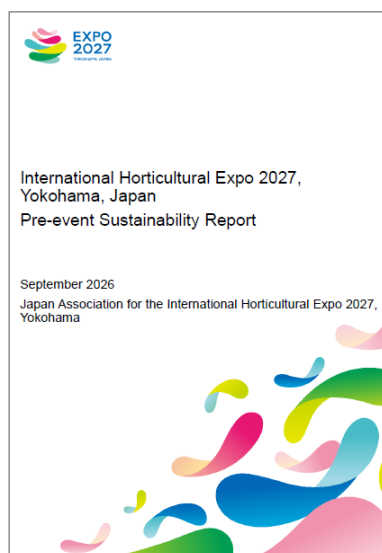

GREEN × EXPO 2027 Publishes Pre-Event Sustainability Report

-Promoting Initiatives Toward a Sustainable Society and Legacy Creation-

GREEN×EXPO 2027, organized by the Japan Association for the International Horticultural Expo 2027, Yokohama (Chairman: Yoshinobu Tsutsui; Office: Naka-ku, City of Yokohama) announced on September 7, 2026, the publication of its Pre-Event Sustainability Report on its official website. The report outlines GREEN×EXPO 2027's engagement in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), initiatives aimed at addressing global challenges, achievements to date, and future preparations and considerations.

By publishing the report prior to the GREEN×EXPO 2027, starting from March 19 next year, the Association aims to share knowledge with a wide range of stakeholders, including participating countries, companies, and organizations. Through this engagement, we further seeks to expand collaboration, create shared value, and build a lasting EXPO legacy.



GREEN×EXPO 2027 is guided by the theme “Scenery of the Future for Happiness.” The Expo aims to contribute to the realization of a sustainable society through harmonious coexistence among nature, the environment, and people. As global challenges such as climate change and biodiversity loss intensify, international expositions are increasingly expected to integrate environmental, social, and economic sustainability into their operations while communicating their achievements to the world.

Based on this vision, the Association has positioned sustainability as a core pillar from the preparation stage of the Expo and has been promoting initiatives that contribute to the achievement of the SDGs and the creation of a lasting legacy.

In addition, the Association has updated its Sustainability Education Plan and Sustainability Communication and Engagement Plan, which were developed in accordance with the rules and guidelines of AIPH (International Association of Horticultural Producers), and submitted the updated plans to AIPH.
